

WEDDINGS IN FIJI – the legal side.

All couples need to register their intent to marry with the Registry office in Nadi. Most resorts will include transfers to the Registry Office, which is open in Nadi from 8.30am-4.00pm Monday – Friday (closed on public holidays). It takes about 30 minutes to complete all formalities.

DOCUMENTATION:

The bride and groom must note the following items to allow a smooth process of registering their intent to marry in Fiji:

1. Certified or original copy of their Birth Certificates
2. Current Passport
3. If previously married, a copy of the divorce/annulment papers
4. Once you have these documents a copy should be sent at least a month prior to us so we can assist you in processing your application.

FEES

Current marriage fees include:

1. Application for special license F20.25
2. Most resort packages include these fees in their wedding packages.
